

# 3 Ways To Give Your Classmates A Bible



### 1. Give Away A Bible As A Present

Buy Bibles and wrap them in wrapping paper. Write encouraging notes for every Bible and person. Hand out them personally or ask a teacher if you can come into every classroom before all the classes start and put each present on your classmates seats. If you want to spice it up with even more love you can add some candy to the present.

**A different way** is giving away a Bible as a birthday present to your classmates! You could also underline specific Bible verses that you think is important for that person.

#### You Need:

### 2. Compete With Your Class

Ask your teacher if you can host the last hour of the class before you go on Easter Holliday. Arrange a Easter quiz, you could use Kahoot. Then serve some snacks, that could be a really fun and cozy time before you got on Easter break. You can give every classmate a Bible as an Easter gift. Why not give it to them before the quiz and then they have to find the answers in the Bible.

**A different way** is to have competitions as a weekly occurrence. For example that every Monday you challenge the class. Whom ever that completes the challenge wins a Bible on Friday and maybe some candy?

#### Example On Competitions:

- Take a selfie with all the teachers at the school
- Tell four people what you appreciate about them.
- Find out why we celebrate Easter
- Take a picture of as many things as possible that starts with the letter E
- Make a bingo badge where your classmates shall find people that fits in to the propositions. For example "Anyone who has more than 2 siblings" or "Someone that has been in more than five countries"

### 3. Tell The Happy Message

Invite your class to church and let the youth pastor tell them about the Christian faith and why we celebrate Easter. This could be a great opportunity to give them a Bible.

**A different way** is that you could ask your teacher if you can talk about your faith during a religion class. You could bring Bibles for those who are interested.
